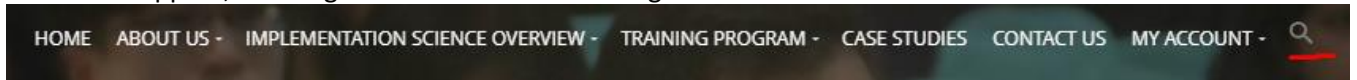
### Call for e-Hub case studies- could your project be the one?

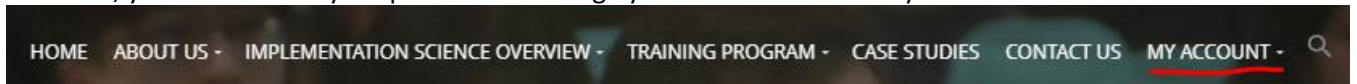
### New development of e-Hub

1. Search function (on the very right side of the menu bar): Type in any keyword, and a list of relevant results will appear, allowing for more efficient sourcing of resources.



2. My account (just next to the “search function on the left)
