Categorizing strategies

 Waltz and colleagues (2015) identified 9 conceptually distinct categories of implementation strategies

Engage consumers

Develop stakeholder interrelationship

Adapt and tailor to the context

Use evaluative and iterative strategies

Utilize financial strategies

Provide interactive assistance

Change infrastructure

Support clinicians

Train and educate stakeholders

The process of selecting and designing strategies

Identify behavioural determinants Select strategies aligned with identified barriers

Tailor strategies to fit the context



Key messages



The creation of a shared language for implementation strategies helps compare research findings



Defining the specifics of implementation strategies increases transparency and enables replication



Local context will influence which strategies are needed and the tailoring required



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
